## DVC By-Laws Section G. REMOVAL

- **G. REMOVAL:** Any Commission or committee member may be removed from office by a four-fifths vote of the Board of Supervisors favoring such removal.
  - 1. The absence of any member from three consecutive regular meetings without good cause shall require the question of removal of that member to be placed on the agenda of the next regularly scheduled meeting. Good cause is defined as a personal or family health issue, family emergency or out-of-town.
  - 2. Written notice of this agenda item shall be given by the Chair to the member and the organization of government office the member represents.
  - 3. Removal of a Commission member shall be by majority vote of eligible voting Commission members.
