Commissioner Lee motions for a DV Feasibility task force, Commissioner Garnette seconds the motion, motion passes by unanimous vote.

  - i. Batterers Treatment Standards- Commissioner Harvey would like to introduce this as a possible task force/committee. - **B.** Marsy's Law, Prop 9 The Victim's Bill of Rights took effect on November 5, 2008. It recognizes that victims have the right to be noticed and to be heard. There are 16 individual rights that the victims should receive in their first contact with a police officer, they include: The right not to talk to a defense attorney

The right to be noticed and heard at every stage in adult or juvenile court

The right to get a copy of the probation report.

The right to a conference with the prosecution.
