1. Call to Order

Jennifer Rose (for Dee O'Brien) proposed a third committee which would focus on bringing together direct service providers. The goal would be to bridge gaps in services, connect and communicate amongst the different groups, with an ultimate goal of providing seamless services to victims and their children and perhaps working toward state and national advocacy.

The commission discussed these proposals.

- 1. The Direct Services Integration Committee
- 2. The Evaluation of Domestic Violence Services Committee
- 3. The Research and Development/Annual Report Committee

The motion was seconded by Laurie McWhorter and approved.
