#### 1. Call to Order

A brief overview of the history, county rules and procedures was provided by the Executive Committee. A financial report prepared by Alan Hiromura was distributed (and is attached to these minutes). It was a determined that there is presently a balance of \$958.13 in the Domestic Violence Commission Trust fund. Kate Canlis reported that George Ow said his contribution was not limited to the video and therefore that amount was moved to reach this total.

The Commissioners were reminded that if they wish to expend monies on behalf of the Commission that they must first submit their request to the Executive Committee. The Executive Committee will then make a decision regarding agendizing the expenditure request. Finally, any action to expend funds must be approved by the Board of Supervisors before the debt is incurred.

A motion was made by Raphael and second by Starn for the Executive Committee to develop a budget in the amount of \$10,000 for submission to the Board of Supervisors. The proposed budget will be presented to Commissioners at the April 11, 2001 meeting. The motion passed.


# 13. Announcements/Oral Communication from Commissioners
