Title VII – Department Procedures

Section 210 – Health Services Agency Facilities Management

- A. Operation
 - 1. The County of Santa Cruz Health Services Agency (HSA) operates various facilities for County government health programs and related purposes.
 - 2. As a secondary use, HSA may make its facilities available to other County departments and agencies, other governmental groups or to recognized health-related non-profit organizations and agencies.
 - 3. All County HSA facilities shall be managed and supervised in accordance with the provisions of California State law, the County Code, County Policy and Procedures Manual, and the Unified Fee Schedule.
 - 4. Further, all County HSA facilities shall be managed and supervised in accordance with the provisions of the HSA Facility Use Policy.
- B. Powers
 - 1. The Health Services Agency may establish additional policies and procedures not inconsistent with the provisions of California State law, the County Code, County Policy and Procedures Manual, Unified Fee Schedule, and the HSA Facility Use Policy, as it deems necessary for safe, efficient, and optimum use of its facilities. Any additional policies will be brought to the Board of Supervisors for adoption within one calendar_year after enactment.
