Approve the Guidelines for Planting and Maintenance of Native California Shrubs and Trees with the following recommendations:

Paragraph one of the Irrigation subsection, add the following at the end of the paragraph: Planting preference is given to fall planting. Irrigation is recommended during dry months

Paragraph two of the Irrigation subsection, change the second sentence to the following: Shrubs can be irrigated with two half gallon per hour emitters and trees with two one gallon per hour emitters for three to five hours a week depending on soils.

8. Project: 151083. APN: 058-101-05

Approve staff recommendation for project 151083 with the following recommendations: In Required Findings for Agricultural Buffer Setback Reductions modify bullet two, second paragraph to the following:

The habitable structure is proposed to be set back 20 feet from the adjacent Commercial Agriculture zoned land. An effective barrier consisting of a six foot tall solid fence and evergreen shrubs providing the required 6 foot height, would be adequate to prevent conflicts between the non-agricultural development and the adjacent Commercial Agriculture zoned land of APN 058-122-12. This barrier, as proposed, shall not create a hazard in terms of the vehicular sight distance necessary for safe passage of traffic.

In Conditions of Approval modify II.A.3. to the following:

Final plans shall show a 6 foot solid board fence and a six foot tall vegetative buffer along the entire rear property line. Vegetative barrier shall be composed of drought tolerant

shrubbery. The shrubs utilized shall attain a minimum height of six feet upon maturity. Species type, plant sizes and spacing shall be indicated on the final plans for review and approval by Planning Department staff.
