# CHAPTER 2.58 HISTORIC RESOURCES COMMISSION

### 2.58.010 Established—Statutory authority.

The Historic Resources Commission is established under the authority of Government Code Section 31000.125208, and in compliance with SCCCChapter 2.38.060-2.38 SCCC. [Ord. 3888 § 1, 1988].

#### 2.58.040 Organization and procedures.

- (A) General Organization. The Commission may establish its own rules and procedures, which shall comply in all respects with the provisions of <u>SCCCChapter 2.38-SCCC</u>.
- (B) County-Staff Support. The Planning Department shall provide staff support for the Commission. The Planning Director or the Director's designee shall serve as Administrative Secretary to the Commission, and shall be responsible for preparingation of all minutes, and staff reports and transmitting Commission recommendations submitted to the Board of Supervisors by the Commission. The staff of the Planning Department shall assist the Commission in discharging its duties with respect to the preparation and administration of historic resource policies, programs and regulations. [Ord. 3888 § 1, 1988].

#### 2.58.050 Powers and duties.

The powers and duties of the Historic Resources Commission shall be to:

(C) Implement the provisions of <u>SCCCChapter 16.42-SCCC</u>, Historic Resource-Preservation, including the review and approval of historic resource preservation plans for the protection, enhancement and preservation of identified historic resources;
