This is the only structure that remains from the Raphael Castro Hotel constructed in 1928 to be the elite private beach club developed by the Aptos Land Company. The structure has been altered and is deteriorated, however the classic style and proportions of the arcade building are present to the degree that rehabilitation may be considered.

The significance of 101 Esplanade is as the last remaining building of the Raphel Castro Hotel and the only remaining commercial building from the Aptos Land Company development that began the resort development in Rio del Mar. Physically deteriorated, the building retains sufficient original architectural elements to provide for listing according to the County historic preservation ordinance.




