Proposal to amend Minor Coastal Development Permit 221351 to remove logs and other wood debris cut and left in place by the Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) following the San Mateo-Santa Cruz Unit (CZU) lightning fire from 37 additional locations across 68 parcels. Requires an amendment to Minor Coastal Development Permit 221351. The associated Biotic Report and Riparian Exception are on file with the Planning Department (application REV221208). An Addendum to the Biotic Report was provided and approved on March 21, 2024. Properties located at various locations within the CZU burn scar in northern Santa Cruz County (see project plans).

APPEALS

^{**} This project requires a Coastal Zone Permit, the approval of which is appealable to the California Coastal Commission. (Grounds for appeal are listed in the County Code Section 13.20.110.) The appeal must be filed with the Coastal Commission within 10 business days of receipt by the Coastal Commission of notice of local action. Approval or denial of the Coastal Zone Permit is appealable. The appeal must be filed within 14 calendar days of action by the decision body.
