Proposed Change to Condition of Approval for Application 211288 – Kitayama

IV. Operational Conditions

- A. Prior to cultivation in any greenhouse used for cannabis cultivation, light deprivation curtains, security, and odor control <u>equipment for the warehouse</u> shall be implemented, including final of the required building permit approved by the Building Official, including clearance of all agency holds, and the Cannabis License shall be issued by the Cannabis Licensing Office.
 - 1. The Odor Abatement Plan for any greenhouse used for cannabis cultivation shall be implemented if one or more odor complaints from the public are received by the County. Verification of complaints by the Monterey Bay Air Resources Board shall not be required. If one or more odor complaints are received by the County, the licensee shall submit a building permit to install the odor abatement equipment within thirty days of notification by the County. This equipment shall be installed within thirty days of Building Permit issuance.
 - a. A noticed hearing before the Zoning Administrator shall be scheduled one year from the date that any cultivation activity commences on the property. The hearing shall be limited to public input regarding odor-related issues.
