IDEAS FOR NEW PROJECTS

- 1. Consider partnership opportunities with the Parks Department, School Districts, and other agencies to provide:
 - a. An expanded teen center to serve the youth of Soquel and Live Oak, and/or
 - b. A **community gymnasium**, which would be available for athletic leagues and performances, and/or
 - c. A Boys and Girls Club in Live Oak
 - d. Expanded year-round use of school **fields for after school and weekend use** (for example fund synthetic turf fields)
- 2. Complete acquisition and development of RODRIGUEZ STREET NEIGHBORHOOD PARK
- Support Parks Department efforts to provide COMMUNITY GARDENS at County Parks (for example at Winkle Farm Park)
- 4. Support Parks Department efforts to MAINTAIN COUNTY PARKS IN A SUSTAINABLE MANNER, including:
 - a. Water conservation
 - b. Use of solar photovoltaics, as appropriate,
 - c. Safety improvements (for example lighting and fencing)
 - d. Study opportunity for a consolidated parks maintenance facility in a mid-county location
