- IN ADDITION TO QUANTITIES INDICATED, CONTRACTOR TO INCLUDE IN THE BID AN ALLOWANCE OF UP TO 50 ADDITIONAL 1-GALLON PLANTS TO BE DRIP IRRIGATED, INSTALLED, AND MAINTAINED PER DRAWINGS AND SPECIFICATIONS AND LOCATED IN THE FIELD BY COUNTY'S REPRESENTATIVE. SPECIES TO BE SIMILAR TO THOSE LISTED ABOVE IN THE PLANT LIST.

PLANTING NOTES

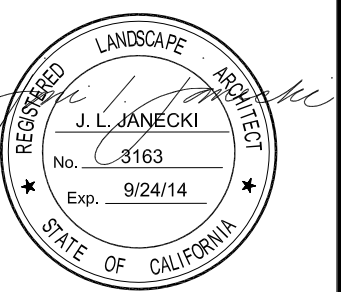
- CONTRACTOR SHALL PROCURE PLANT SPECIES OR EVIDENCE OF AGREEMENTS TO PROVIDE ALL SPECIES WITHIN THIRTY (30) DAYS OF AWARD OF THE CONTRACT. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR PLACING REQUIRED DEPOSITS TO ENSURE TIMELY PROCUREMENT OF THE SPECIFIED PLANTS. CONTRACTOR SHALL PROVIDE COUNTY'S REPRESENTATIVE WITH WRITTEN VERIFICATION (RECEIPTS/CONTRACTS) SHOWING PROCUREMENT TO MEET THE PLANTING REQUIREMENTS. CONTRACTOR MAY, WELL IN ADVANCE OF TIME OF INSTALLATION NEED TO ENGAGE IN CONTRACT WITH GROWERS TO ENSURE PLANT AVAILABILITY.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL INSPECT THE PLANTS 6 AND 1-MONTH PRIOR TO PLANT DELIVERY DATE TO ENSURE THE QUALITY OF PLANT MATERIALS MEETS OR EXCEEDS THE SPECIFICATIONS.
- HOLD FINISH GRADES FOR PLANTING AREAS 1/2 INCHES BELOW TOP OF ADJACENT PAVEMENT OR WALLS, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED ON THE DRAWINGS.
- GRADUALLY ROUND OFF TOPS AND TOES OF ALL PLANTED SLOPES TO PRODUCE A SMOOTH AND NATURAL TRANSITION BETWEEN EXISTING PLANTINGS, FINISH GRADES AND NEW PLANTINGS.
- ALL EXISTING TREES AND PLANTS SHALL BE PROTECTED IN PLACE UNLESS NOTED OTHERWISE. CONTRACTOR SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR DAMAGE OF ANY KIND TO EXISTING TREES AND PLANTS DURING THE COURSE OF CONSTRUCTION.
- PLACE 2-INCH LAYER OF GRAVEL MULCH IN ALL PLANTING AREAS EXCEPT ON SLOPE, UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED ON THE DRAWINGS. REFER TO SPECIFICATIONS FOR GRAVEL TYPE.
- PLANT QUANTITIES ARE TO BE BASED ON FIELD OBSERVATION AND NOTED. NEW PLANTINGS ARE INTENDED TO INTEGRATE WITH EXISTING VEGETATION.
- IN ADDITION TO QUANTITIES OF TREES GIVEN, SUPPLY 2 PERCENT OF THE TOTAL NUMBER OF TREES OR A MINIMUM OF 1 TREE IN EACH SPECIES FOR INSPECTION. THE TREES TO BE INSPECTED WILL BE RANDOMLY SELECTED BY THE COUNTY'S REPRESENTATIVE UPON DELIVERY AT THE SITE PRIOR TO ACCEPTANCE OF PLANTS.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL NOTIFY THE COUNTY'S REPRESENTATIVE A MINIMUM OF FIVE (5) DAYS IN ADVANCE TO SCHEDULE PLANT DELIVERY DATES. THE COUNTY'S REPRESENTATIVE SHALL REVIEW PLANTS UPON ARRIVAL, AND RESERVES THE RIGHT TO REJECT PLANTS FOR ANY REASON IF DEEMED UNSUITABLE.
- THE CONTRACTOR SHALL PLACE PLANTS AS SHOWN ON PLAN AND VERIFY LOCATION WITH COUNTY'S REPRESENTATIVE. COUNTY'S REPRESENTATIVE MAY REQUEST THAT CONTRACTOR ADJUST OR RELOCATE PLANTS ON-SITE AS NEEDED TO PROPERLY MEET THE DESIGN INTENT.
- THE ABOVE NOTES, PLANT SECTION AND LIST, DETAILS AND PLANT PROTECTION MEASURES HAVE BEEN REVIEWED BY PATTI KREIBERG, SUNSET COAST NURSERY.
